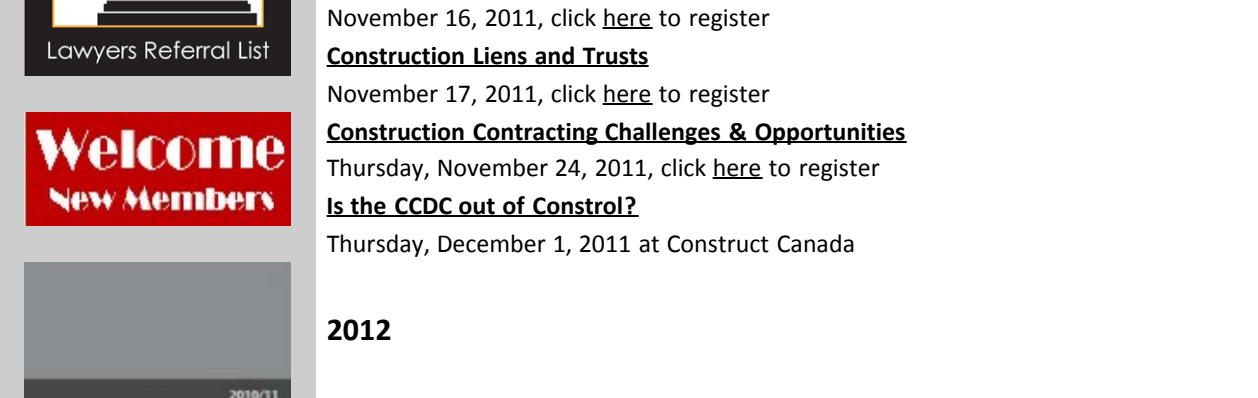

TCA-11-1467-New Student Residence, University of Western Ontario
(Close date: November 23, 2011)

Construction of a 1000 bed (400 units) residence of approximately 370,000 square feet in a compilation of 4 interconnected 6 storey towers. The building will be complete with study/activity rooms, lounges and dining hall with full central kitchen facility. The construction will consist of poured concrete structure with masonry and curtain wall. Extensive landscaping and a 200 vehicle surface parking lot will complete the project. The expected value of work will be approximately \$65M. Completion is expected August 2013.
